This Bird was originally discovered by Tim Flood on Saturday December 12, 2020. The bird was relocated by Adam Stein, Ronnie Reed, and Kav McGeough on Monday December 14, 2020 in the same location.

Although American Tree Sparrow is likely a rare but regular winter visitor to areas of northern Arizona, there are VERY few records for the southern portion of the state, where it is casual at best.
